Dress Code

ALL STUDENTS GRADES 1-8

Pants – Navy blue or khaki dress pants (no jeans style or cut)

Shirts – White, yellow or blue oxford shirts, polo shirts, or blouses

Turtlenecks – Solid white, navy blue or yellow

May be worn under oxford shirt, blouses, jumpers or sweaters

Shoes – Tennis shoes or dress black or brown shoes (Shoes should have minimal, if any decorations)

(**Grades K- 8**) – No boots, high heels, sandals, backless, slip-on or clogs

Shorts – Navy or khaki knee length

From: August 15 to October 15

April 15 to the end of school with the above colored shirts

Sweatshirts – St. Mary logo sweatshirts only

Sweaters – Navy or white sweater/cardigan - V-neck, crew neck, buttoned

Girls, Grades 1-4

Jumpers – Navy blue or school plaid jumpers with above colored shirts

Skorts – Navy blue or khaki skorts with above colored shirts or blouses

Tights – Navy blue or white tights may be worn with jumpers

Capris – Navy blue or khaki – plain style with above colored shirts or blouses

Girls, Grades 5-8

Skirts – Navy blue or school plaid skirts with above colored shirts

Skorts – Navy blue or khaki skorts with above colored shirts

Capris – Navy blue or khaki – plain style with above colored shirts or blouses

Physical Education – All students in Grades 4-8

Solid white or St. Mary logo t-shirts

Navy blue shorts

White socks

Winter Months – optional solid white or blue sweatshirt and sweatpants

Grades K-8 - Gym shoes

General Guidelines for all students:

Belts must be worn.

Shirts and blouses must be tucked into pants, skirts, and skorts and buttoned appropriately.

Jewelry should be conservative and tasteful.

Earrings – Girls – No long, dangling earrings Boys – No earrings

Girls - No heavy make-up

Hair should be clean and neatly groomed.

No baggy, sagging pants below the waist.

Special dress up days and casual days will be available periodically during the year.

Since dress code guidelines cannot take into account all circumstances, the final decision on approved dress code shall rest with the Principal.

DRESS CODE VIOLATIONS

1. First time – Verbal warning to student and note to parent
2. Second time – Parents will be called
3. Third time – Detention
4. Fourth time – Parents meet with Principal
